Last week you saw the beginnings of the transition of a pretty unattractive area of our church yard to a planned prayer garden. It took much planning and many resources.

You may or may not already know that the Prayer Garden's planning and development was not funded through our annual budget process. So how did it come about?

The Prayer Garden has always been funded via grants, individual generous donations, and donated time from individuals. As an example, the concrete contractor donated a \$1,000.00 gift towards the building of the garden. They had learned that the Prayer Garden was not limited to use by church members. Instead it was developed with use by the community in mind. Another example is Presbytery's contribution of grant monies to go towards the Prayer Garden.

But how is the Prayer Garden funded now that it is built? The major source of financial support is derived from semi-annual plant sales planned and carried out by the GPC Prayer Garden group. And while the group plans these plant sales, it is you, GPC congregants, and friends of Grace that make these events successful by providing support in the form of purchasing plants. It is because of this support that we were able to build the garden and to continue making repairs and providing all necessary maintenance.

Over the years GPC members have provided continued support. For example, it is because of Jim and Joan Smith that we have a very nice water fountain in the Garden. The community has also provided human resources to help develop the garden. The Boy Scouts have taken on numerous Eagle Scout projects to help us with the garden. They poured concrete, prepared the soil, and if you look at the southeast section of the garden you'll see a memorial wall they built.

And now that we have a beautiful Garden, the Prayer Garden Committee invites everyone to a **Dedication Ceremony** to take place from **9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. on May 5, 2024.**Sunday school will be suspended on that day. During that time brunch will be served, a brief ribbon cutting will take place and a video presentation will show highlights of the Prayer Garden evolution. So, if you are able, we ask that you bring your favorite breakfast dish to share at the brunch and brief ceremony. A sign-up sheet is available in the Narthex.
